



Door County Farm Bureau Scholarship Application

Application Deadline: postmarked by April 1, 2019

Description:

Two recipients may be selected to receive two (2) \$500 scholarships, awarded by the Door County Farm Bureau.

Eligibility:

- a) Applicants planning to pursue post-secondary education enrolling in any type of major/program with preference given to those students intending to enroll in an agriculture or agriculturally related field. (Undergraduate degree at an accredited four-year college/university, Associate degree at any Wisconsin technical college, Farm and Industry Short Course at UW-Madison)
- b) Applicant or applicant's family must prove paid membership of the Door County Farm Bureau for at least one year prior to application.

Selection Criteria:

- a) Involvement in FFA and/or 4-H, community and additional school activities
- b) Two (2) letters of recommendation from school, employer, or other community members, but not family members
- c) Copy of high school transcript

Administration and Awarding of Scholarship:

- a) Final selection and awarding of the scholarships to be made by the Door County Farm Bureau Scholarship Selection Committee.

Rules Regulating Use of Scholarship:

- a) Scholarship recipient must show proof of successful completion of the first semester (usually a copy of a grade report) and enrollment for the second semester (copy of completed registration form). This proof must be mailed to the address above.
- b) Scholarship will be paid directly to the school after completion of the first semester.
