



Scholarship Application
Deadline: April 1, 2019

1. Applicant must hold a current Farm Bureau/Rural Mutual Insurance membership or have parent or legal guardian that is a current member to receive a scholarship (obtained by April 30, 2018).
2. A total of \$2,000 will be divided among two to four applicants, at the discretion of the scholarship committee, with no less than \$500 awarded to one applicant.
3. The application must be complete, including a letter of recommendation and 300- to 500-word essay on: The Value of Wisconsin Farm Bureau to be eligible.
4. Payment of scholarship award will be made by the Wood County Farm Bureau after receiving next semester college grades.
5. The applicant is strongly encouraged to volunteer in the Wood County Farm Bureau ice cream stand at the Central Wisconsin State Fair.
6. All applicants will be notified by June 1.

Applications are due to the scholarship committee chair by April 1, 2019.
