# GET READY FOR THE 2020 AMERICAN FARM BUREAU ANNUAL CONVENTION!



The 101st Annual Convention of the American Farm Bureau Federation will be held January 17-22, 2020, in Austin, Texas. You are invited to join the Wisconsin delegation as we travel to "Longhorn Country" for the AFBF Convention & IDEAg Trade Show. Enclosed you will find registration forms and information regarding the convention program.

**Transportation:** Transportation arrangements to Austin are the responsibility of the individual(s) attending. WFBF will arrange air transportation for YFA award winners and delegates.

**Hotel:** The Wisconsin delegation will be staying at the Hilton Austin, located at 500 East 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Austin, TX 78701; phone: 512.482.8000. Room rate is \$248 per night plus tax. The hotel is connected by skywalk to the Austin Convention Center, site of the AFBF Annual Convention. **Airport Transportation:** The Hilton Austin is located approximately 7 miles from Austin-Bergstrom International Airport. *Austin Super Shuttle* provides transportation between the airport and the hotel for an approximate cost of \$16 per person one way. Taxi service is available from the ground transportation level of the airport terminals. Approximate taxi fare from the airport to the hotel is \$30 one way.

**Registration Fee:** The AFBF registration fee covers entrance to all general sessions, issue conferences, and the AFBF IDEAg Trade Show. The cost is \$100 for Farm Bureau members and \$250 for non-members. Children age 17 and younger are free of charge, however those age 12-17 are required to register so that they have a name badge.

**Wisconsin Delegation Reception & Dinner:** The traditional WFBF Delegation Reception/Dinner (\$85 per person) will be at 7 p.m. on Saturday, January 18, at Moonshine Patio Bar & Grill, located at 303 Red River St, a one-block walk from the Hilton. This function will provide a great opportunity to meet with other members of our delegation and receive an update on the convention and related activities.

**Optional Ag Tours:** Texas Farm Bureau will offer a number of exciting agricultural tours on Saturday, January 18th and Tuesday, January 21<sup>st</sup>.
