Qualifications:

1. Applicant or applicant's parent must be a current Rock County Farm Bureau Member. If applicant is over age 21, he/she must have his/her own Farm Bureau membership in Rock County.
2. Applicant or member of applicant's family must have worked a previous year or will work in the Rock County Farm Bureau Food Stand at the 2023 Rock County 4-H Fair.
3. Applicant must be in at least their second year of college or technical school.
4. Applicants are eligible to receive the scholarship for two years.
5. GPA must be 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale.
6. The deadline to apply is **April 1st**. Scholarship presentation will take place at the Rock County Farm Bureau Annual Meeting in September 2023.
