The Shawano County Farm Bureau is an organization of producers and agribusiness professionals with the mission “to lead the farm and rural community through legislative representation, education, public relations and leader development.” As part of this goal, the Shawano County Farm Bureau strives to promote agricultural education for the students of Shawano County by awarding annual scholarships generated by our Shawano County Brunch on the Farm to be used university, college or technical college program.

Criteria for Selection: The applicant must:

- Be a Shawano County resident or have been a student at a Shawano County High School
- Be pursuing an agriculture-related degree at a university or technical college. Ag-related degrees will be given preference, but all degree areas will be considered.
- Have volunteered at one or more Shawano County Brunch on the Farm events.
- Provide evidence of educational achievement.
- Demonstrate a record of active participation in extracurricular activities.

Scholarships: Up to six scholarships may be awarded.

- Each scholarship shall be up to \$500 to students pursuing a degree or certificate at a university, college or technical college.

Application Process: The following items must be received by March 3, 2023

- Completed scholarship application form.
- Copy of most recent transcripts (unofficial transcripts are acceptable).
- One letter of recommendation

- Scholarship funds will be distributed after evidence is provided documenting a semester with an earned 2.0 GPA or higher. Applicants will have up to two semesters to demonstrate at least a 2.0 GPA.
