The Ozaukee County Farm Bureau is making available scholarships to Ozaukee County students to aid in the pursuit of higher or continued education and who meet the qualifications listed below.

#### Rules and Regulations:

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded at the recommendation of the scholarship committee with approval of the Ozaukee County Farm Bureau Board of Directors. Scholarship amounts will be awarded as follows:
  - a High School Senior or First-time scholarship applicants \$650 \$1000
  - b Second to Fourth time scholarship applicants \$1000 \$1500
  - c The scholarship committee has the right to adjust any scholarship amount.
- 2. The recipient(s) must be (or intend to be) registered, full-time students (12 credits or more) at any accredited technical school or university for continuing education in Agriculture or an Agricultural related field. Non-agricultural related field of study will be considered for First time applicant only.
- 3. The application form must be filled out and submitted to the scholarship committee **not later than** March 29, 2024 with the essay and at least two recommendation letters from any of the following people:4-H leaders, Principal, teacher or advisor, local community leader, clergyman, or employer.
- 4. The scholarship committee will base their selection upon:
  - A. Activities, including participation in 4-H, FFA, other Ag related activities, school, community, and full/part time employment.
  - B. Submit an original essay including the following topics:
    - a. "Why I am choosing a career in ."
    - b. "The importance of Agriculture in Ozaukee County."
    - c. "How has agriculture impacted me?"
  - C. Character of applicant.
  - D. Letters of recommendation.
  - E. Transcript of high school or continuing education grades.
- 5. Preference will be given to students of families who are current Ozaukee County Farm Bureau members.
- 6. Preference will be given to students who are residents of Ozaukee County.
- 7. Second to fourth time scholarship applicants only: Preference will be given to students who are registered members of their accredited university or technical school's Collegiate Farm Bureau or continuing members of FFA beyond high school.
- 8. If no worthy candidate is found, the committee reserves the right to withhold the awarding of any scholarship.
- 9. Payment of scholarships will be made to the recipient(s) after the completion of the first term following the scholarship award and after they have supplied the committee with a copy of their grade transcript showing a 2.5 (C+) grade point equivalent or better.
- 10. Any scholarship recipient is required to volunteer one shift (4 hours) at the Farm Bureau Fair food stand the year they receive their scholarship.
