Rules & Regulations

- Up to four scholarships of \$1000 each will be awarded with preference given to agriculture related majors, but open to all majors.
- Parents, grandparents, or individuals must be a member of the Racine County Farm Bureau for at least one year before applying.
- Applicants must be a high school senior or continuing education student in a four-year college, technical school, short course program, or trade school. Applicants are eligible to win once as a high school senior and once in continuing education.
- Two letters of reference; both of which may not be a family member or relative.
- Submit a recent picture of yourself with the application.
- If no worthy candidate is found, Racine County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee reserves the right to withhold the scholarship(s).
- Applicants must submit a transcript of their schooling.

- Please write an essay of no more than 400 words describing your personal future goals.
- Please write an essay in no more than 400 words giving any other information that may be helpful to the scholarship committee.
