RE: Delayed 2024 Dairy Margin Coverage Enrollment

Dear Deputy Under Secretary Montaño Greene and Administrator Ducheneaux,

As members of the Wisconsin State Legislature, we appreciate the U.S. Department of Agriculture for their dedicated review of the dairy pricing formula. Your ongoing commitment to fostering fairness and stability within the dairy industry is critical, and we implore you to expedite these efforts through any available means.

Wisconsin's dairy industry leads the country in Dairy Margin Coverage (DMC) program enrollees with over 4,000 farms enrolled. This figure equates to nearly 80% of Wisconsin's dairy farms, which is a testament to the critical role the DMC program plays in our agricultural landscape. As our state's dairy industry faces challenges, the timely initiation of DMC enrollment is paramount to ensuring the program effectively serves its intended purpose as a risk management tool.

The DMC program serves as a safeguard for dairy producers during periods of low margin, stemming from depressed milk prices, elevated feed costs, or both. DMC program payments are triggered when margins are at their worst, and timely payments are at their highest importance. In June and July 2023, the DMC program's catastrophic coverage margin level of \$4 per hundredweight was breached for the first two times since the program's 2019 beginning. Without the lifeline of DMC payments, numerous farms would have struggled to remain operational. The current delay in payments poses a threat to farm cash flow, exacerbating the risk of additional herd losses due to financial strain.

We urge the Farm Service Agency to leverage its full authority to expedite the publication of necessary rules and implement essential technological software updates to facilitate the opening of DMC enrollment, without delay. Further postponements only heighten the vulnerability of dairy farmers, subjecting them to unnecessary risk and uncertainty in an already challenging environment.

Thank you for your continued support of Wisconsin agriculture.
