1. Applicants or their parent(s)/guardian(s) must be a member of Dane County Farm Bureau.
 2. Applicants must be a high school senior or currently enrolled in post-secondary education.
 3. Preference will be given to applicants enrolled in an agriculture program.
 4. Applications must be completed in full and submitted by **APRIL 1**. Incomplete or applications submitted after April 1, may be disqualified.
 5. Scholarship recognition will take place at the Dane County Farm Bureau annual meeting in September. Scholarship payment will be mailed to recipient after submitting his/her fall semester transcript to Dane County Farm Bureau, as early as January the following year.
 6. Previous scholarship recipients cannot apply again for the scholarship.
 7. Judges will use the following criteria for evaluation: Academics 50 percent; activities and awards 30 percent; and need 20 percent.
 8. \$1,000 scholarship.
