Reaction time, pre-operational procedures, tractor components, repairing equipment, grain storage handling, entrapment demonstration, self-propelled equipment, atv/utv safety, skid steer, practical driving training.

## **Day Three (4/18)**

### **Allenton Fire Department**

**431 Railroad St. Allenton**

PTO & hydraulics, first aid & emergency response, written exam, practical driving test.



- Learn a safe attitude with farm equipment, animals and other agricultural hazards.
- Per Federal and State law, to drive an implement on the highway or to work for someone other than family, this training is required.
- Receive a state certificate for successfully completing the course, along with a certification card.
- Instructors will include those involved in farming, maintenance, law enforcement and emergency response.
